Assist managers and upper-management at the company to understand how the economy will affect its business, including analysis of issues such as consumer demand and sales, applicant's common business and financing needs, lending requirements and loan readiness

Collaborate with Business Consultant staff to assess client needs and develop recommendations, including action plans, internal TA resources, and referral opportunities regarding the evaluation and underwriting of loan applications

Provide technical assistance to Community Enterprise Development Services finance clients during the processing and underwriting of loan applications, and supporting the loan department

Formulate recommendations, policies, reports, and plants to interpret and solve economic problems and present research findings and strategy proposals to company funders and Executive Director
